# STAFFING

There are currently 4 staff that support 2 physicians. We have a full-time orthopedic surgeon as well as a part-time urologist. The 2 physicians see inpatient and outpatients and perform surgical procedures. Dr. Reis our orthopedic surgeon continues to provide cutting-edge procedures and had the learning mobile out for hands on illustration of a new rotator cuff procedure that increases range of motion on specific types of patients.

# Moreno Valley Clinic Expansion

On January 27<sup>th</sup> the orthopedic clinic team went to Moreno Valley to get the clinic information systems tested and process flow reviews completed for the patient visits to begin in two weeks. The team is hopeful that new patients will respond to the added access to orthopedics in the community.
